

# STOP A GUN TRAGEDY

## With a Gun Violence Restraining Order (GVRO) in San Francisco

**What is a GVRO?** It is a civil court order to temporarily remove firearms and ammunition and prevent new purchases.

**Why a GVRO?** An individual at risk of dangerous behavior will often inform those closest to them when they are in a crisis or may harm themselves or others.

### Who can seek a GVRO?

Law enforcement  
Immediate family member  
Spouse or domestic partner  
Roommate

Dating partner  
Teacher and classmate  
Employer and co-worker

**How to obtain a GVRO in San Francisco?** For non-emergency situations, contact your local police station so that an SFPD officer can evaluate if a GVRO needs to be filed.
