Donate a Tent:

The Department of Homelessness and Supportive Housing is encouraging folks in tents to shelter in place and, whenever

possible, to limit the number of folks in tents in order to avoid the spread of droplets caused by coughing/sneezing.' In a time of social distancing, self-quarantining, and shelter-in-place orders, and with limited sanitation facilities, a tent is an unhoused person's only line of defense against COVID-19 infection.
